SB 1383 requires local jurisdictions to monitor contamination and proper sorting of organics by performing annual route audits.

EMADCO and Madera County may be in your neighborhood throughout the year performing "lid-flips" and checking carts to ensure materials are sorted correctly.

WHAT ITEMS CAN GO IN THE GREEN CART?

Food scraps like fruits and vegetables, cooked meat and bones, eggshells, nutshells, bread, rice, and pasta can all go in the green cart. Yard trimmings, grass clippings, and untreated wood are also accepted, along with food-soiled paper such as napkins, paper towels, and pizza boxes.

REMEMBER Have your Carts out by 7:00 a.m.

Place carts at least
3 feet apart.
