- Metal Jar Lids
- Flattened Cans
- Copper, Brass & Aluminum

### PAPER

- Catalogs
- Magazines
- Cardboard
- Newspapers
- Milk Cartons
- Drink Boxes
- Scrap Paper
- Phone Books
- Shredded Paper (bagged)
- Clean Pizza Boxes
