PUBLIC NOTICE

RE: Waste Collection Rate Adjustment- Effective July 1, 2021

Dear Madera County Resident or Business:

This notice is to advise you of an adjustment to the solid waste and recycling collection service fees in Madera County. As you may know, the County considered forgoing the annual rate adjustment on July 1, 2021 due to a proposed rate adjustment that would have been effective January 1, 2022 in response to service changes associated with Senate Bill 1383 (Short-lived Climate Pollutants – Organic Waste Reductions). However, the implementation of the service changes in Madera County for SB 1383 have been postponed by the Board, pending further developments related to the implementation of the SB 1383 regulations.

As a result, the regular annual adjustments to solid waste and recycling collection service fees will be implemented in accordance with contractually based adjustments in the consumer price index, fuel pricing and recycling costs. These rate adjustments will be effective on July 1, 2021 and will be invoiced by the franchise haulers (Emadco in the mountain franchise area, and Redrock in the valley franchise area) to their respective customers.
