Due to expected high traffic volumes, this event is first come, first served.

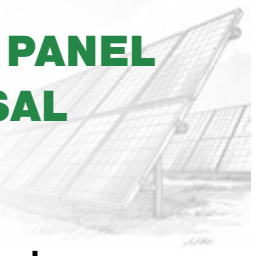
